



Huron Yacht Club Dock Rules

1. HYC shall not be held responsible for or have any liability whatsoever for any loss, damage, personal injury or loss of life or property within the control of the Marina, it's employees or its agents in connection with (1) HYC's premises or the use of its facilities; (2) the owners vessel, motor, accessories, including tools, and associated equipment; (3) any loss due to fire, theft, vandalism, collision, marina equipment failure, windstorm, rain, tornado, or any other casualty loss. Owner agrees to cover aforesaid risks by appropriate insurance without subrogation against HYC.
2. Quiet hours are **11:00 P.M. To 8:00 A.M.**
3. Pets shall be kept on a leash and not chained or tied to any HYC property. Owners are responsible to clean up after pets.
4. Anyone discharging holding tanks or toilets into the Marina will have their dockage agreement immediately terminated and will cause the immediate removal of the Owners Boat from the Marina at owners expense. All paid dockage will be forfeited. Emptying of portable toilets in the restrooms is prohibited.
5. Swimming and/or diving is prohibited within the Marina by the Health Department of Erie County.
6. Open fires are not permitted on docks, piers, boats or anywhere on HYC premises.
7. Owners or operators of vessels shall immediately reimburse HYC for any damage or defacement, which they or their vessel may cause to HYC property.
8. Disorder, depredations, public intoxication, profanity or abusive language by a boat owner, employees, visitors, family or other will cause the immediate removal of the vessel and all parties.
9. If you are in an incident there must be a Huron Police report or a United States Coast Guard incident report completed. Huron Police 419-433-5568. USCG 419-798-4444
10. Children under the age of six (6) years of age should be accompanied by an adult when on the docks and shall be wearing an approved PFD.
11. Refueling of any vessel with a portable container(s) is prohibited within the Marina.
12. Refuse and garbage must not be thrown over board. All garbage must be confined to a plastic bag and shall be deposited in cans supplied for that purpose. No person shall discharge oil; spirits, flammable liquids or oily bilges into the Marina or trash receptacles, under any circumstances.
13. By order of the Erie County Health Department, fish cleaning is prohibited within the Marina.
14. No firearms, fireworks, sparklers etc. are allowed on the grounds of HYC at anytime.
15. Upon breach of any of the terms of the Agreement by Boat Owner, Boat Owners' Family, Friends or Guests, HYC may cancel and terminate the Agreement with no refund.
